## THE YACHT

Built in 2011 as the Italian yard Perini Navi's 51st masterpiece, the 45 metre sloop Clan VIII is the ultimate charter yacht for ocean going adventures. Optimised for performance cruising, with some personal tweaks by her experienced owner, she is the ideal platform for family and friends to connect with the ocean in an authentic way.

Clan VIII's naval architecture is the work of Ron Holland in collaboration with Perini Navi. Her 52 metre mast can carry a total sail surface of 900 square metres, and she can reach speeds of up to 13 knots whether under sail or under power thanks to her main Caterpillar C32 820 kw diesel engine. Notably, with a keel that retracts from 8.7 to just 3.9 metres, she can confidently access shallow and remote anchorages that other luxury sailing yachts cannot.

Fresh in the ranks of captain, Ashley Taylor has been at the helm of Clan VIII for the last two years, and he says the crew is where the superyacht

– which he describes as a 'home away from home' really shines.

"We are professional but friendly," he says. "We enjoy what we do and love to show our guests what we love about our jobs and our surroundings. Our sense of adventure is infectious and yet we are always safe and professional."



## THE EXPERIENCE

Clan VIII accommodates six guests in three cabins on the lower deck, consisting of a full beam master suite, one double and one twin cabins. For maximum flexibility, the gym can be transformed into an additional cabin to make for a total of eight guests accommodated on board.

Inside, guests are welcomed to a stylish and modern interior with glossy pale ceilings and warm colours which give the main salon a relaxed and homely feel.

On the sun deck, guests are treated to spectacular panoramic views, and it's here that guests tend to spend most of their time.

"The cushioned area on this deck is perfect for relaxing in the sun, and the kids love the beanbags," explains the captain. A large L-shaped sofa is located on the starboard side with an even roomier sunbed situated aft.

"Another fantastic area on board is the bow settee," he continues, "especially if dolphins are playing in the bow wave!"

"We don't have any computer games on board," explains the captain. "If the weather gets in our way, there is always teaching guests how to tie knots and other fundamentals of sailing if they are interested. We have chess, backgammon and cards on board plus a selection of DVDs, but only as a backup!"



## TENDERS AND TOYS

With a functional fold-out transom that transforms into a sizeable seven metre square swim platform, it's from here that a Clan VIII ocean adventure begins. Perfectly set up for diving and watersports, those who are passionate about marine life and getting out on the water will truly appreciate what she has to offer.

"Life on Clan VIII is all about the outdoors: watersports, fishing trips, whale watching and BBQs on the beach. Having a big swim platform from which to jump into the water or board a paddleboard makes everything so much easier and safer" says Captain Ashley.

Guests can also take advantage of the stylish Conrad Pischel jet tender to take them ashore and between islands, as well as a state-of-the-art wakeboard, water skis and two SeaBob F7s, meaning there's no time to get bored, whatever your age.

For those looking to get up close and personal with the local marine life, Clan VIII also offers rendezvous diving and has plenty of snorkelling gear so you can take to the waters whenever and wherever the opportunities arise.

From catching your own fresh fish for that evening's dinner to sunbathing on the large swim platform, Clan VIII is an ideal charter yacht for both rest and play.
